



Press Release for JA2012 The Society of Japanese Aerospace Companies

The Society of Japanese Aerospace Companies (SJAC) is the sole public entity representing the interests of the Japanese aerospace industry and has contributed to the growth of our aerospace industry with a total of 150 major companies in Japan.

SJAC holds an international exhibition almost every four years with participation of the world's major aerospace companies and authorities. Based on the success of JA2008 in Yokohama, we plan to have the next exhibition in Nagova region.

Nagoya region is Asia's largest hub for aerospace manufacturing and it's combined sales of aerospace components ranks 5th in the world. The region has the international airport opened in 2005 and features suitable place for the aircraft exhibition.

Now we are pleased to have an opportunity to inform about Japan International Aerospace Exhibition 2012 (JA2012) at the Farnborough.

1. Title

2. Concept of JA2012

- ① Aiming at the leading international aerospace exhibition in Asia
- The exhibition provides the opportunities to access the most advanced technologies and to exchange views in trade, since the Nagoya region is the largest manufacturing site in Asia.
- 3 Japanese developed aircraft will be exhibited at the international airport.

3. Schedule & Venue

- ① Trade exhibition is scheduled at "Port Messe Nagoya" from Oct.9 (Tue) to Oct.12 (Fri) 2012
- ② Public exhibition is scheduled at "Port Messe Nagoya" & "Central Japan International Airport (CENTRAIR) from Oct.12 to Oct. 14(Sun)





4. Record of JA2008

JA2008 took place at Pacifico Yokohama with exhibitors of 529 companies and organizations including 150 from 21 foreign countries. The visitors for the trade were around 11,000 and 32,000 for the public event. According to the survey, 98% of trade exhibitors were satisfied.

5. JA2012 Specialty

① Attractive Business- matching Opportunities

The outstanding buyers will participate from all over the world. During JA2012 suppliers will be able to closely see the supply chain policy of the buyers. The opportunities of One to One meetings will be arranged through the electronic network system. The Web system will support the business opportunities for exhibitors.

② Advanced Technology is focused

The suppliers have opportunities to display their technologies. The seminars/symposia/conferences will be arranged for the related topics and activities. The local companies around Nagoya region and the SMEs all over Japan will show the high level technologies and products. The space pavilion will be set up to show the latest development of Japanese space industry.
